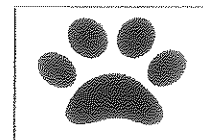

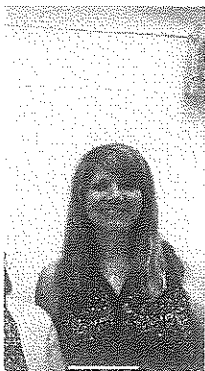
### Did you know...

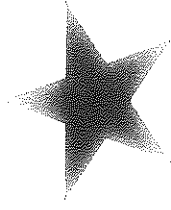

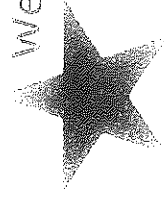

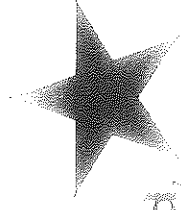
