The Kenton County Board of Education has approved the KCS D instructional delivery model for the 2021-2022 school year as follows:

- In person learning five days a week following required guidelines from KDE, KDPH, and the CDC  
OR
- Virtual learning program as adopted by the KCS D Board of Education on 9/9/2019 (pre-pandemic)

Synchronous learning will only be available for students who are quarantined by the local health department or district/school personnel should we still be required to quarantine individuals.

The virtual learning model that will be utilized will be the model adopted by our Board of Education before the pandemic. This program consist of an application and contract to ensure that students enrolled in this model are on track, remain on track and learning at high levels. This model ensures that we meet the expectations of the district vision that every student is transition ready and prepared for the 21<sup>st</sup> Century economy.
