Hello Team Kenton and our extended family,

The district will remain in synchronous/virtual learning on Monday, January 4th and Tuesday, January 5th. Students and staff will return to in-person instruction on Wednesday, January 6th utilizing the A/B Rotational Model we have been following which is an “Aggressive Hybrid” model. All students will continue to meet ‘Healthy at School Safety Expectations’ at all times. If students selected the Virtual Learning Academy or the full time synchronous model they will remain in those selected models unless they have decided to change with their schools. Additionally, we are recommending a new District In-Person Learning Matrix to our Board of Education to guide our decision making process beginning January 6th, 2021. This Matrix was developed in compliance with all Healthy at School guidelines and the Governors Executive Order. Also, this Matrix is developed to mitigate risk from COVID-19 for our students, staff and family’s while also mitigating risk for our students’ academic well-being and our students/staff social emotional well-being.
