PARKING RULES AND REGULATIONS 2018-2019

Permits will be assigned based on priority need, with primary consideration given to school-related activities (Early Morning classes, Gemini College Academy, After School College, Academic Internship, etc.) and secondary consideration for other personal needs. Junior scholars parking needs are considered after all seniors receive parking permits and will be based on After School College scholars attending the Academies in the afternoon session. Scholars with late applications, incomplete applications, or those not approved will need to wait until the next issue date. You may not park on campus unless you have been assigned a parking tag. Drivers are not allowed to have riders to or from the Academies.

Scholars must have all information complete on the application, including signatures before the application will be considered. In order to park on school property, Scholars must pay a \$20.00 maintenance fee. The Scholar will be required to show a valid driver's license at the time of issuance of the permit. **The permit must be hung from the rear-view mirror AT ALL TIMES.** Loss of the hanger will result in requirement for Scholar to pay a replacement cost of \$20.00.

PARKING RESTRICTIONS – To park at school each driver must hold a valid permit issued by the Kenton County Academies of Innovation and Technology and a valid driver's license (intermediate). If you are assigned to a lot you must park in that lot. Designated lots/spots are the only place a driver with a permit may park. Transferring your parking pass to another Scholar for any reason is prohibited.

Under all circumstances, buses have the right-of-way, and Scholars should yield to both loading and moving buses.

Early Morning Classes are from 7:00 – 7:55am. All drivers must be in the building by 6:55am

Morning Academies are from 8:00 – 8:35am. All drivers must be in the building by 7:50am

Afternoon Academies are from 11:40 – 2:10pm. All drivers must be in the building by 11:30am

WARNING - VEHICLES SUBJECT TO SEARCH

Any vehicle on school property is subject to search at the discretion of school authorities. A search may be conducted without warrant for any reasonable purpose. Search of the vehicle includes all compartments and components thereof. Once notified of intent to search, the person in control of the vehicle will not be permitted to remove it from the premises until the search is completed.

The Academies, Kenton County Board of Education, and its employees are not liable for any theft or damage to vehicles while on any school lots. Scholars are encouraged to lock vehicles.

Having a parking permit is a privilege not to be taken lightly. Any Scholar who abuses the privilege through unsafe driving, improper parking, truancy, detention, or repeated tardiness, will have the permit revoked.

Parking a vehicle in the staff lot, another's reserved space or failure to abide by any of these regulations will result in loss of future parking privileges, Scholar detention, and additional consequences.

Any items that are questionable will need to be removed before parking. Failure to comply will result in removal of permit for remainder of school year.

A valid insurance agency and policy are required by the Kenton County Board of Education. Proof of insurance may be requested.

In this world of increasing litigation and liability, agreeing to transport a passenger in the car with your teen-age driver could result in a costly, and at times, tragic consequence. It is recommended that the parent discuss this issue with the Scholar and make a determination as to acceptable and safe operation of a motor vehicle and acceptable passengers to be transported in the vehicle. Additionally, I have read all rules and will support any action taken by the school should my child fail to abide by them.
