

The Kenton County School District Basketball League
Grades 4 and 5
2021-22
General Information

The purpose of this league is to introduce young boys and girls to the fundamentals of basketball and to allow them opportunities to become leaders through empowerment, encouragement, and teamwork. All who sign up will be **placed** on a team with students of their own gender and from their home school. Players will be assigned to a team to promote equality among all teams. The goal of this league is to help build school spirit and build lasting relationships.

All schools in Kenton County will have both boys and girls team(s) for 4th and 5th grade students. For the 2021-22 basketball season, some teams may play a school from a different division due to gym restrictions or amount of teams. The divisions are as follows:

Each week, your child's team will compete against a team from his/her grade level and gender. All games will be played at one of the schools' gymnasiums. All games will be played on Saturdays between 8AM-4PM. All teams will be scheduled a minimum of 60 minutes of practice per week during the season and the two weeks leading up to the season. Games will begin Saturday, February 26th and end on Saturday, April 9th.

All coaches will be notified by the school Athletics/Activities Director the week of January 24th. After notification, volunteer coaches will need to fill out a volunteer background check and are required to attend a mandatory coaches meeting with the school's Athletics/Activities Director (time and date TBD).

All parents of players will be required to attend a mandatory meeting with the school's principal and/or Athletics/Activities Director. (Date and time will be announced at a later date.)

The cost of the league is \$60.00 per child. This will cover the expenses of the league, plus provide each child with a t-shirt. Please complete the attached form to register your child in this league.

There will not be a charge for admission to the regular season games. League rules (modified version of the KHSAA) will be distributed to players, coaches, and family members prior to the start of the season.
