

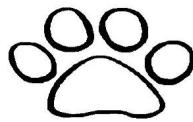

School Closures due to weather?...SNOW Problem!

The district completed an approved application through KDE for NTI (Non Traditional Instruction) days to be included in the district calendar as student attendance days for the school year due to a potential need to close for our facilities to in person instruction due to weather or unforeseen circumstances. The use of NTI days will allow a continuation of instruction for all students due to an emergency situation or weather. The below information outlines the structure of these NTI days.

-Students will continue to work on familiar technology platforms (Google, LMS, etc.) and/or packets that will be sent home in advance.

-Staff will be available and serve as instructional facilitators via technology to assist students/parents as needed during the school day.

-Student participation (attendance) will be based on interaction with the teacher either by completed work product, technology, email, phone, etc. Teachers will record student participation.
