

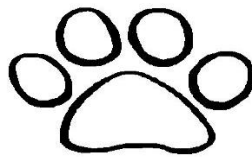

Cafeteria: “Golden Spoon Awards” will resume October 4th in the cafeteria. Please take a few minutes to remind your students that their class will be working to earn points each day. At the end of each week, one class from each grade level will receive a Golden Spoon trophy to display in their classroom and keep on the lunch table.

Golden Spoon Expectations

- We will enter the cafeteria in a voice level 0
- We will walk at all times
- We will speak to the people at our table at voice level 2
- We will get our napkins, drink, straw, and silverware before we sit down
- We will use polite words to others including the cafeteria staff
- We will raise our hands if we need anything
- We will take all of our trash when we leave, including what has dropped on the floor
- We will place our tray in the trash, leaving all food and drink in the cafeteria
- We will line up at voice Level 0
