Important Information for Parent Pick Up / Car Riders

- ★ Please do not arrive for Parent Pick up before 3:00. Our new Car Rider Pro System is set to start reading car tags at 3:00. If you arrive before 3:00pm your car rider tag will not be read and you will be asked to circle back around.
- ★ In order to ensure the safety of all of our students, we must use the Car Rider Pro # System. If you do not have a car tag, you will also be asked to circle around and enter the office, with an id, in order to pick your child up.



Please see the reminder about masks below:

- Fit snugly but comfortably against the side of the face
 - Be secured with ties or ear loops
 - Include multiple layers of fabric
 - Allow for breathing without restriction
 - Be able to be laundered and machine dried without damage or change to shape
 - Cover both nose and mouth
 - A face covering with an exhalation valve should not be used as it allows unfiltered exhaled air to escape to others.
- We have had a lot of questions regarding "gaiters," and they will be permitted. Ideally all face coverings should have two or more layers of fabric.

If your child does not have a mask to follow these guidelines or forgets their mask we have masks at school that they can use.

Mask Breaks and Snacks

The students will receive mask breaks - weather permitting. For classes that have a snack break, snack time will take place during a scheduled mask break.



Student Materials



Reminder that students will bring all materials necessary for instruction home with them each night. Chromebooks should be charged at home and all materials should be brought back to school each day. This will allow students to continue to receive instruction in the case of an unexpected closure.
