

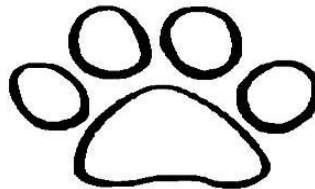

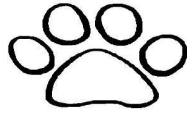

The MAP Testing Window begins October 13th. Please look for information from your child's teacher on testing dates. Please encourage your child to get a good night's rest and eat a healthy breakfast the morning of MAP Testing. This is a norm-referenced test that allows us to collect data in order to provide instructional support for students based on their individualized academic success on the test. The test is administered through the computer and needs to be completed independently.
