

Cell Phone Use Policy and Procedures

All cell phones must be turned off upon entering the school building and remain turned off until the 20 minutes after the school day (2:55 pm). All devices must be stored in a secure in assigned lockers.

Use of communication devices is banned at all times during the school day, on school busses, during school functions, and during any assigned detention, including but not limited to Friday School, etc. If a student is using their phone while the phone is concealed, the standard discipline will be applied. Many students are text messaging while the phone is in their pockets or purses. (Cell phones should remain in the student's assigned locker.) This is a disruption to the learning environment and is clearly against school policy.

Any use of picture phones to transmit personal images or school course evaluation materials will be dealt with as a serious breach of security and disciplined accordingly.

Any violations of these usage policies will result in disciplinary measures. Chronic noncompliance will result in PERMANENT loss of privileges.

The Kenton County School District accepts no responsibility for use, breakage, theft or loss of these personal items.

1st Offense: Student will be sent to the Assistant Principal's office and the offense will be entered into the student records.

2nd Offense: Student will be sent to the Assistant Principal's office and will be given one day of after school detention.

3rd Offense: Parent conference will be scheduled and the student will receive one day of ISS.

Additionally, repeated violations will result in loss of other privileges or further disciplinary actions.
