The 21st Century Community Learning Center Morning Program is designed to enhance school day learning. Students will be given Homework Help when needed and participate in computer based learning, as well as, other enrichment activities.

Drop off time is between 7:00 and 7:15 a.m. on Monday through Thursday (NO 21st CCLC programing on Fridays). Doors are locked and no one will be available to let student in after 7:15 each day. The morning program will run until 8:30, when students will be dropped off in the cafeteria. Enrollment is on a first come first serve basis and is limited to 24 students.

***Please note that the 21st CCLC Morning Program is for enrichment purposes only and is not a child care program. It is completely separate from the AlphaBest BeforeSchool Program.**
